We are pleased to welcome you into the family of Saint Ignatius College Prep. We are aware that in many instances, families have a greater challenge in trying to meet the rising costs of secondary education today.

Since the school began in 1870, the Tuition Assistance Program has provided monetary assistance to families whose children can benefit from our academic programs, but who cannot afford the full cost of tuition. Parents and guardians who feel there would be difficulty in meeting the cost of tuition are encouraged to apply for assistance. When determining financial need, both parents' financial resources are considered. If parents file separately for any reason, both must submit an application. The awards are grants funded by benefactors of Saint Ignatius College Prep and work-study programs.

In all instances, the program covers only costs for tuition and all families must contribute something towards tuition. Applying for tuition assistance does not guarantee receiving such. Please provide copies of all supporting documents as they will not be returned.

Your son or daughter demonstrated that he/she belongs in our Saint Ignatius family. Please do not hesitate to complete the registration forms because of concerns over financial matters. You will receive notification of your award within three weeks of our receipt.

Saint Ignatius College Prep works closely with several outside scholarship programs. Each scholarship organization should be contacted directly.

The deadline for applications for the 2010-2011 school year is Friday, March 26, 2010.
